

Work the Polls on Election Day!

Thank you for your interest in the election process! The Kershaw County Board of Elections and Voter Registration is always looking for new Poll Managers to staff precincts throughout Kershaw County.

Poll Managers have a unique opportunity to serve the community, meet their neighbors, and become involved in the democratic process. They are also compensated \$60 for each election they work plus \$60 for attending the poll workers training class.

Election Day duties include: processing of voters, ballot distribution, activation of the voting system, compliance with election law and procedures, and general assistance to voters.

In order to apply, YOU MUST:

- **Be a registered voter in Kershaw County, or an adjoining county (Richland, Lee, Lancaster or Fairfield County), or aged 16 or 17.**
- **Be willing and able to attend a Poll Manager Training Session (2-3 hours) and pass a written certification test before EACH election.**
- **Be prepared to work the ENTIRE Election Day, from 6:15AM until approximately 7:30PM.**
- **Be non-partisan and neutral when working an election.**
