City of Camden Services During SC State of Emergency

Camden, SC – The City of Camden utility business will be maintained and serviced as normal, following SC Governor Henry McMaster’s declaration of a State of Emergency. The City will suspend the normal disconnect for non-pay procedures until further notice.

Residents are encouraged to use the City’s online bill pay for existing utility bills at www.cityofcamden.org. There is also a drop box just outside the Finance Department entrance at City Hall, where payments will be accepted 24 hours a day.

City staff will continue to monitor the COVID19 virus and make operational decisions as necessary.
