

TEE BALL LEAGUE RULES (AGE 4-5)

PLAYING

1) The game will consist of three innings or one hour, whichever comes first. All innings started before the hour time limit will be finished.

A) There will be no official score kept and there will be no umpires used for the games. Games will run themselves with the coaches overseeing things.

2) All players will bat every inning, regardless of the number of outs recorded. The leadoff batter for the first inning should be the last batter in the second inning and then revert back to being the leadoff batter in the third inning.

A) All players will play defense with a maximum of six players in the infield.

3) No stealing or bunting allowed.

4) No in-field fly rule allowed.

5) The ball must be thrown to put runners out. No rolling of the ball will be allowed.

6) Runners may not advance on overthrows.

COACHES

- Two defensive coaches are allowed in the outfield. One defensive coach is also allowed in the infield. Coaches may instruct their team from these positions but cannot interfere with the game.
